MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of Holy Family Parish is to help people to believe in Christ, to belong to His Church, and to bless our communities. We strive to fulfill our mission through worship, evangelization, faith formation, stewardship, fellowship, and service.

SACRED PURPOSE STATEMENT

To evangelize, welcome, encourage, inspire, and support with Christ as our model, so that all may be engaged in our church and community. We do this by being generous in sharing our faith and letting others know that we care.

GOALS TO IMPLEMENT FIRST

CORE MISSION PRIORITY • Worship

Archdiocese of Baltimore Definition: To engage in prayer, worship, and the sacramental life fully and intentionally, that flows from Holy Baptism and reverential participation in the Holy Eucharist, the source and summit of our faith.

GOAL 3 (as listed in the Pastoral Plan)

Consult with worshippers via survey to make decisions about the following issues:

- Sunday Holy Mass at 7:30 AM: ascertain interest in having music.
- -- Sunday Holy Mass at 11 AM: ascertain interest in expanding the music repertoire.

GOAL 4 (as listed in the Pastoral Plan)

To enhance the worship experience during Sunday Holy Mass at 11 AM by forming an Adult Choir and a Children's Choir.

CORE MISSION PRIORITY • Evangelization

Archdiocese of Baltimore Definition: To continually experience our own conversion and bring others to experience the same through evangelization. Revealing the truth of the Gospel and witnessing to others how we are encountering Christ.

GOAL 2 (as listed in the Pastoral Plan)

Develop and execute strategies to reach out to inactive Catholics and others, particularly on Ash Wednesday, Christmas, and Easter.

CORE MISSION PRIORITY • Faith Formation

Archdiocese of Baltimore Definition: To grow together as disciples of Christ as we study, share, and live according to the teachings of Christ and His Church through education, faith formation, and making disciples.

GOAL 1 (as listed in the Pastoral Plan)

Enhance the efforts of the Sunday School of Religion to partner with parents in forming disciples of Christ within His Church. Recruit and form Sunday School of Religion staff. Develop and execute strategies to increase the participation of young disciples in the Sunday School of Religion.

CORE MISSION PRIORITY • Stewardship

Archdiocese of Baltimore Definition: To enact wise stewardship of the gifts that God has granted us and the legacy entrusted to us by those who have preceded us in the faith, and the hope that lies in future generations of the faithful, so that our resources may be channeled to support the mission of making disciples first and Foremost

GOAL 1 (as listed in the Pastoral Plan)

Establish a committee to examine the feasibility of renovating the former school building into a Parish Mission Center.

GOAL 5 (as listed in the Pastoral Plan)

Develop a process to engage parishioners in the ministries and organizations of the parish.
